Description	The proposed investment program will help achieve the National Capital Territory of Delhi (NCTD) Water Supply Master Plan objective of reduced non-revenue water (NRW) and equitable access to water supply services. It comprises: (i) physical investments to improve existing water supply systems covering 2.6 million people in the Wazirabad water treatment plant (WTP) command area (approximately 10% of Delhi's population by 2021), and (ii) non-physical investments to improve Delhi Jal Board's (DJB) institutional effectiveness with an aim to adopt a corporate approach in the long term by developing organizational options addressing the institutional and financial management capacity of DJB.
Project Rationale and Linkage to Country/Regional Strategy	The Delhi Water Supply Improvement Investment Program, in line with the ADB's water operational plan, will improve the performance of the existing water supply services to 2.6 million people residing in North East Delhi and improve the management capacity of the DJB, the service utility responsible for water supply and sanitation services in the NCTD covering about 18.85 million people.

Involuntary Resettlement	Involuntary Resettlement Category: B The WTP reconstruction and rehabilitation work will be undertaken on the existing site while the water network improvement will be undertaken along the existing right of way. However, temporary impacts are expected during the water network improvement, which will be identified and mitigated through a Resettlement Plan.
Indigenous Peoples	Indigenous peoples Category: C Delhi is generally homogeneous in the random distribution of groups across it. It is inhabited by population that has migrated to the city and does not house indigenous people.
